Graphics Formats Everything to Know, and More

There are, understandably, many different kinds of formats for graphics on a computer. Why? Well, each time a new program came along, a new format was invented, made for that specific program. Then, when computer graphics became popular, different formats battled each other out: "Which is better?" Some formats offered features others did not. For instance, a PSD, or Photoshop Document, offers you the ability to keep your layers. A TIFF file can include an alpha channel. And GIF images can contain a script so that things "move," the animated GIF file.

Below are some commonly found graphics formats, and a little about each one.

PNG	Portable Network Graphics format	PNGs come in several different flavors, and is a file format developed to combine the best of the JPEG and GIF formats in one new format. Unfortunately, it still has not gained wide acceptance. PNGs can include transparency, indexed color, plus the full 24-bit color gamut.	Yes, not supported in older browsers.	.png
PICT	Macintosh Picture	A OS-derived file format for the Macintosh. More or less equivalent to the Windows BMP format. Fairly good quality, 24-bit color, built-in compression.	No.	(none), .pict
EPS	Encapsulated Post Script	A 'default' format for PostScript, vector artwork. EPS file contain mathematical formulas for vector artwork, plus a small bitmapped "preview" image for programs that cannot render the vector artwork.
